<p>Review School-wide Data and determining goals for the 2024-25 school year.</p>	<p>Florance</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Typically we have a literacy and math goal that are achievable for our students. • This year we will also split goals by grades K-2 & 3-8. • Did not meet literacy and math goals for grades 3-7, exceeded literacy goal for K-2. • Goals for this year have been adjusted accordingly, along with stretch goals. • In general we have some numbers that are comparable or better than GCS. • We don't have DIBELS finished for K-2 yet this year, so that goal will be set once we have data established. • We used ENSI for K-2 math last year, but we are shifting to IXL math for this year, so we will set that goal once data has been established for those grade levels as well. • Our charter is up for renewal this year, and the main criteria is our academic performance compared to the local LEA. Proficiency 3-8: 1 point away from GCS <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Black student Proficiency overall: 5 points ahead of GCS ○ EDS Proficiency overall: 2 points ahead of GCS ○ Black student Proficiency in Math: 8 points ahead of GCS ○ EDS Proficiency in Math: 1 point ahead of GCS ○ Black student Proficiency in Science: 5 points ahead of GCS ○ EDS Proficiency in Science: 2 points ahead of GCS (EDS – Economically Disadvantaged Students)
